He has a broad based investigative and supervisory experience encompassing over 400 federal and state violations including Violent Crime, Terrorism, White Collar Crime, Cyber Crime, Narcotics, Crimes Against Children, Property Crime, and Foreign Counter Intelligence. He has been the Case Agent and multi-agency task force supervisor on numerous high-profile, death penalty investigations including serial murder, kidnapping, serial sexual assault, and single homicide investigations. Mr. Trombitas has been a Consultant to local, state, and federal agencies, high schools/colleges, and businesses on School/Workplace Violence Assessment and Prevention. He has created multiple information-sharing networks between law enforcement and private sectors, the first of their kind in the FBI, targeting Violent Crime, Crimes against Children, Cyber Crime, Financial Institution Crime, and Homeland Security Issues.

Mr. Trombitas served on numerous dignitary protection details including FBI Directors William H. Webster, Louis J. Freeh, and William S. Sessions as well as Attorneys General John Ashcroft, Janet Reno, Edwin Meese III, and William Barr. During his FBI career he has been a Consultant to financial Institutions regarding Physical Security, Employee Training, Marketing, Executive Officer Protection, and Threat Assessment. He was appointed by the Governor of Ohio to the inaugural Ohio Amber Alert Committee in 2003 and currently serving on the AMBER Steering Committee that oversees the Ohio's Amber Alert plan.

He has been the keynote speaker at numerous national and international conferences in the areas of Major Case Management, School/Workplace/Church Violence Assessment and Prevention, Crimes Against Children, Kidnaping, Financial Crime, Media Relations, and Cyber Crime.
