Mr. Creedon retired from the Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI) with a 24-year career as an FBI Special Agent that allowed him to serve in three different states where he gained a wide range of investigative and critical incident response experiences. In his varied assignments, Mr. Creedon worked with local, state and other federal agencies widening the scope of his investigative and special assignments. He worked foreign counterintelligence and organized crime in New York City. While assigned to Dallas, Texas he investigated general criminal matters that included fugitives, murder, drug organizations, organized crime, bank robberies and kidnappings.

As a Senior Associate for ARMADA Ltd., Mr. Creedon oversees the organizations investigative capabilities as well as supports security threat and vulnerability assessments, both domestically and internationally as well as human behavior threat assessments. Mr. Creedon has provided services to corporations, law firms, government entities and higher education. Those areas of service have included employee embezzlement, loss prevention analysis, workplace violence investigations and prevention, wrongful death investigations, breach of contract, fraud and mortgage fraud, investigation and review of complex corporate mergers and manipulation of publically traded stock. Mr. Creedon has also taught safety and security courses to college age students and courses addressing workplace violence and radicalization to the United States Marine Corps. As a Special Agent serving in Ohio, Mr. Creedon investigated wire fraud, mail fraud, foreign counterintelligence, general criminal matters to include bank robberies, armored car robberies, fugitives and kidnappings. Additionally, Mr. Creedon investigated serial and cold case murders in conjunction with local police authorities. Mr. Creedon organized major cases in foreign counterintelligence, espionage, wire and mail fraud and the murder of federal witnesses. In the course of his duties, Mr. Creedon drafted search and arrest warrants and was responsible for the collecting and organizing of evidence. Mr. Creedon has presented cases to numerous Grand Juries and testified in numerous state and federal trials to include capital murder prosecutions in both state and federal courts, bank robberies, kidnappings and complex white collar crime cases. Mr. Creedon was also a member of the Special Weapons and Tactics Team (SWAT) while serving in Ohio. As a SWAT member, Mr. Creedon participated in numerous high risk warrants and provided incident command on complex operations.

Prior to entering the Federal Bureau of investigation Mr. Creedon was a Naval Reserve Officer. He also was employed with Ashland Chemical Company in the Industrial Chemicals and Solvents Division, the Georgia Pacific Chemical Company in the Resin Division and also with McKesson Chemical. Mr. Creedon also worked for Baxter Travenol in the Chemistry and Therapeutic Division.

Mr. Creedon graduated from Ohio Dominican University in December of 1971 with a B. A. in History. Mr. Creedon graduated from Capital University Law School in 1982 with a Juris Doctor degree. He was admitted to the Ohio Bar in November of 1982.
