Sergeant McVey is considered a Subject Matter Expert with regards to Incident Command training and it's use for planning and coordination of major special events, to include the City of Columbus' annual Red, White and Boom, 4th of July Fireworks event that is consistently held up by the Department of Homeland Security as a Best Practice for Incident Command implementation. The last 6 months of his career Timothy supervised the Counter Terrorism Unit.

Timothy holds both Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program (HSEEP) and Department of Homeland Security Master Exercise Practitioner (MEP) certificates and has served in over 70 multi-agency, multi-jurisdictional exercises as a: federal point of contact (for DHS); design team member; controller; evaluator; and law enforcement subject matter expert.
